Armadillos loose in Salford!



As much as we all get irritated at times, I'm sure that we're all in favour of making our roads safer for cyclists - but should this be at the expense of other road users' safety, namely us? Salford Council are trialling "segregated cycle lanes" using "**armadillos**" - scary lumps of plastic that have been bolted to the road to separate cycles from the traffic. The council claim that the armadillos have been "used successfully in Europe for a number of years" and are trialling two sites:

Liverpool Street

Approximately 80 metres of semi-segregated cycle lane have been implemented on the westbound carriageway of Liverpool Road, between Albion Way and Cross Lane.

Middlewood Street

Approximately 70 metres of semi segregated cycle lanes have been provided on Middlewood Street eastbound.

No cyclist in their right mind would trust these things to save their lives. They won't deter cab drivers from swinging into the kerb to pick up or drop off punters. Buses or trucks, cyclists' biggest threat, will hardly notice them. A motorcycle, however, could easily come unstuck if it clips one inadvertently.

The council is "very interested in receiving feedback" on the trial sites from all users, which will help in "evaluating the product, and influence how we progress with segregated cycle lanes in the future". So, it's all still to play for. MAG is already in talks with the council but you can add your voice by emailing cyclesalford@urbanvision.org.uk


