

Changing the Guard at the Motorcycle Alliance Party



Manchester rep Jimmy T has, for the last few years, also chaired the Motorcycle Alliance Party. This is dedicated to raising the awareness, and championing the rights of bikers. Now Jimmy feels that it is time for him to step back and give someone else a chance. Jimmy writes...

"As 2011 was drawing to an end, the North Manchester Motorcycle Alliance (later to become the Northwest Motorcycle Alliance) held a meeting with the view that in order to combat policing problems in Manchester we should form a political body. So, the Motorcycle

Alliance Party (MAP) was born in January 2012. An application was made to the Electoral Commission and we became official in February 2012. Our first aim was to have a candidate stand for the role of Police Commissioner in Greater Manchester. Then HM Government changed the rules and added so many exclusions that, we felt, it made a farce of the democratic system. We decided to target our energies elsewhere. We have fielded candidates in council elections, Mike Yarwood standing in Salford as well as Jimmy T standing in Withington and gaining a whopping 1% of the vote (a true "one percenter", if ever there was one!). However, it is the fact that we are putting up candidates, who could potentially take away votes from more established parties, that raises our profile. MAP has given both MAG and the NW Alliance another stick with which to defend freedom and our way of life. Politicians are more likely to listen.

Sadly however, I (as founder and party chairman) have taken the decision to pass on the baton of responsibility in the near future, owing to a combination of age (63) and ill health, having been paralyzed recently after a stroke. Thankfully I am now in recovery.

Thus we now seek nominations to take over as Party Chairman, until such a time I will remain in the post assisted by the Treasurer Bill Green to whom all Nominations should be addressed."

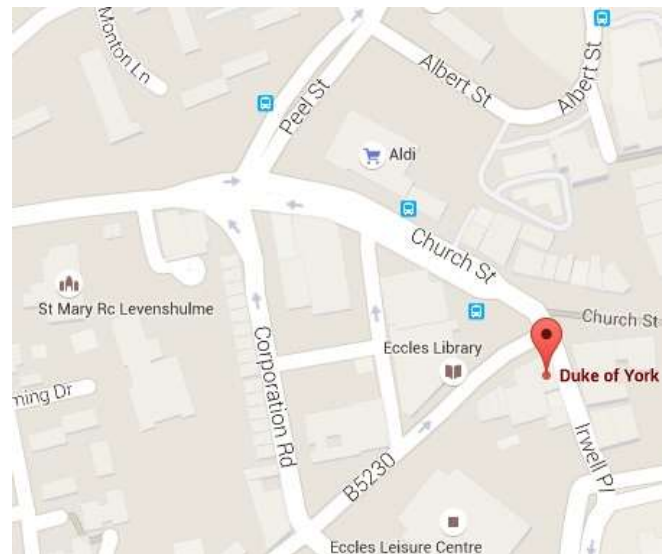
