Backtrack on fossil fuels?

The government has admitted that certain types of diesel and petrol engine vehicles may be allowed after 2040. It seems that zero might not mean zero. New "ultraclean" engines may be manufactured to meet government targets of *"pretty much zero"* emissions by that time, although it is envisioned that the vast majority of vehicles will be totally zero emission. Some MP's have claimed that the motor industry has been kept in the dark about what exactly "zero emission" will mean though and whether such "ultraclean" internal combustion engines will comply. Once that is clear they can get on with developing vehicles that fit the bill. Who knows what the future might hold?

Manufacturers Watsonian-Squire are reporting a surge in demand in decades for their sidecars. Much of this growth is from "millennials" (those reaching adulthood this century) who seem to appreciate the old time looks and build quality. Ben Matthews from the company says "*The current boom in retro bikes like the Triumph Bonneville and Royal Enfield Bullet have attracted a new, younger crowd onto three wheels. We're selling them to people who want to carry their young children or dog with them when they go for a ride".* It's still a far cry from the 1950's, when there were an estimated 100 000 combinations on the road, but it's a move in the right direction.




North West Motorcycle Alliance
